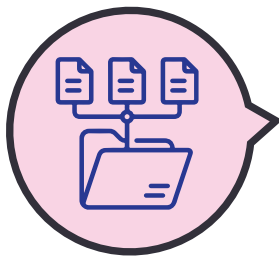

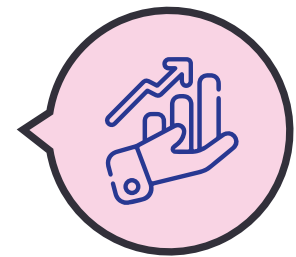
The Program

The connection between GRCS and the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals) and how organizations address this issue at the board level.



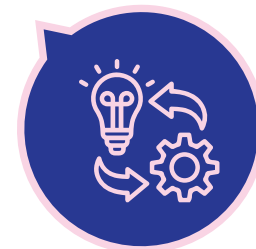
Strategies for effectively addressing GRCS challenges and maximizing the potential benefits and opportunities that GRCS initiatives offer.

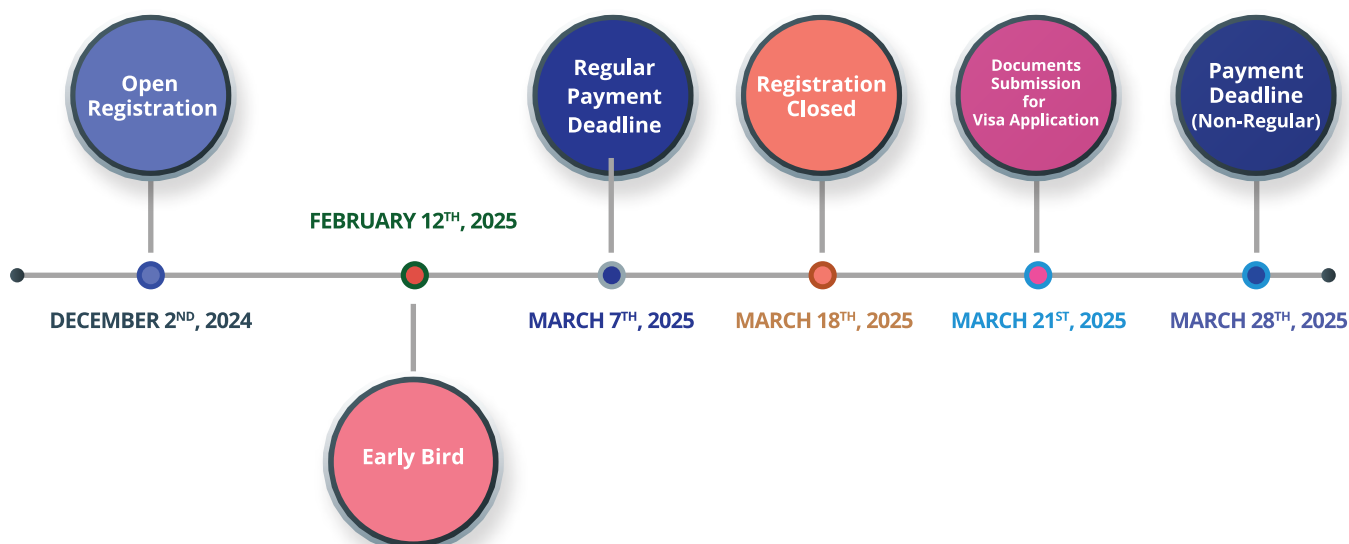
