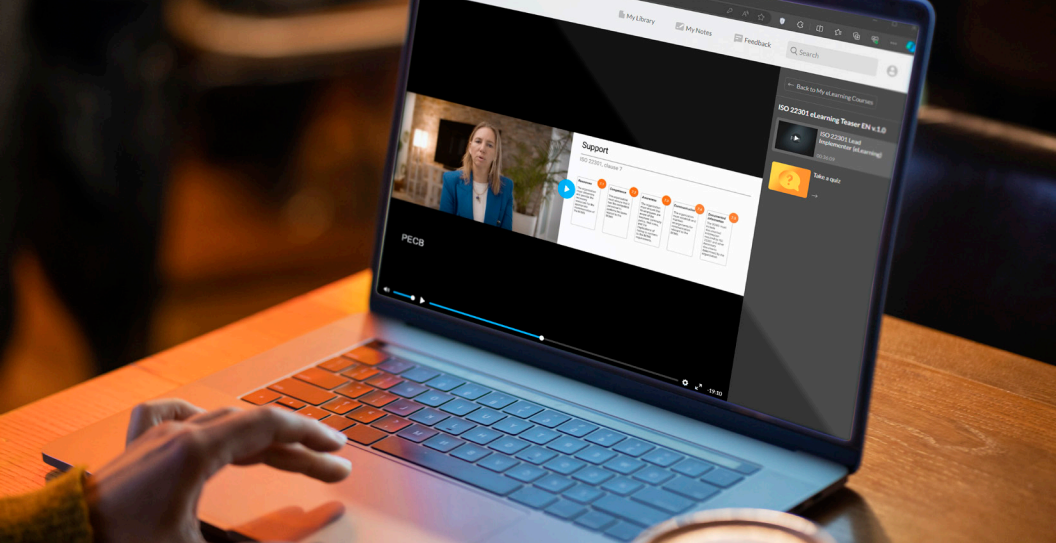
PECB eLearning vs. PECB Skills

PECB eLearning courses focus on structured courses similar to PECB's professional training courses, whereas PECB Skills offers a flexible, subscription-based model with a diverse array of video capsules, emphasizing continual improvement and expertise enhancement.

PECB eLearning

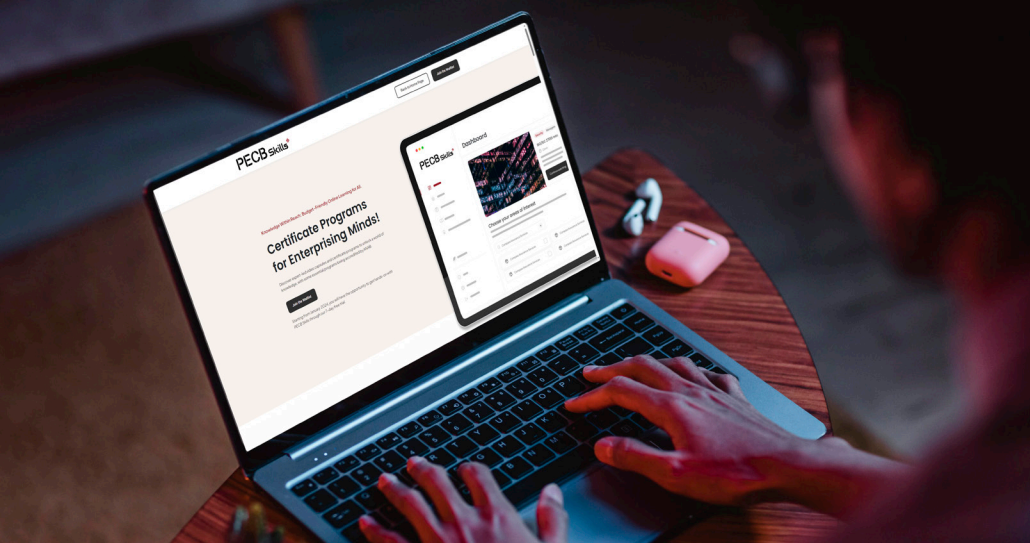
PECB eLearning provides conventional PECB training courses in an online format. This includes training courses for Lead Implementer, Auditor, or Manager credentials. The video lectures are uploaded on PECB's online platforms along with the written training materials.

Purchasing Model

eLearning training courses, just like their conventional counterparts, can be purchased via PECB partners. The smallest purchasable unit is a single eLearning training course. Specific video sections cannot be purchased individually.

Credentials

Upon course completion, PECB eLearning provides attestation of course completion, the CPD credits, and, upon completion of exam and other requirements, a certificate. These hold equivalent value to those obtained through traditional classroom or live online sessions.



PECB Skills

Introduced in 2023, PECB Skills is a new online learning platform that offers diverse learning materials. These materials are presented in the form of video capsules, covering a wide variety of topics with different levels of depth and complexity.

Subscription Model

PECB Skills is a subscription-based platform with its own dedicated platform. The subscription grants subscribers access to the entire PECB Skills library. There is no limit to the smallest amount of video capsules that can be accessed, providing flexibility in learning.

Credentials

In addition to delivering high-quality learning material, PECB Skills also offers credentials such as CPD credits, attestations of completion, and competency certificates. These credentials further validate the acquired knowledge and skills.
